Locals put money where their mouth is

BAKERS Delight Gawler sold the second highest number of buns across the state for the inaugural Women's and Children's Hospital (WCH) Foundation Bun Day.

One dollar from every six-pack of Bakers Delight buns sold on March 8 was donated to the foundation to help children with tracheotomies.

WCH Foundation executive manager Michelle Eunson said local residents really got behind the initiative.

"Bakers Delight Gawler sold an incredible 1086 hot cross buns during

the day which was the second highest amount sold by any store," she said.

"We're thrilled that Gawler residents were so supportive of the initiative."

Funds raised from the Bun Day will go towards the purchase of vital medical equipment for children who have had tracheotomies at the hospital, including new suction machines and oximeters.

Oximeters alert parents if their child is having problems breathing at night, or when they are asleep, and the suction unit keeps the tracheotomy tube clear so the child can breathe.
